Introduction

Traffic accidents cause the death of more than 1.25 million people in the world. They are the ninth cause of death among people of all ages and the leading cause of death among people aged between 15 and 29 years.

When in March 2010, the United Nations General Assembly proclaimed the period 2011-2020 decade of Action for road safety proposed to Member States that **Carry out activities in the field of road safety**, particularly in the areas of road safety management, road infrastructure, vehicle safety, **The behavior of road Education for road safety and post-accident care**, indicating as priority:

- Develop comprehensive programs to improve the behavior of road users.
- Permanent observance or empowerment of laws and regulations **In combination with education or public awareness** To increase the rates of use of the seat belt and the helmet, and to reduce driving under the effects of alcohol, speed and other risk factors.

AIPSEV-ONGD Organizer of the CIPSEVI 2019, assumes the UN's sustainable development goals for 2030, adopted by all Member States in September 2015 in the General Assembly of the United Nations and especially those related to road safety, which Proposed for 2020 to halve the number of deaths and injuries caused by road traffic accidents in the world and for 2030, provide access to safe, affordable, accessible and sustainable transportation systems for all and improve road safety, in Particular by expanding public transport, paying particular attention to the needs of vulnerable people, women, children, persons with disabilities and older persons.
